From the Pastor's Study

Dear Beulah Church Family,

May 2010

During this Easter season (*remember Easter in the church is a seven-week season, which ends on the Day of Pentecost, this year May 23*), I have been preaching on the lectionary readings from the Book of Revelation. This is the only time in the three-year Revised Common Lectionary Cycle that there is a series of readings from Revelation.

All of these scheduled readings avoid some of the more graphic, violent material in this book and focus more on readings which fit into the larger theme of the Easter season – the resurrection of Jesus Christ, worship before God and Jesus as the “Lamb” who was slaughtered and now raised, and the final consummation of God’s plan of salvation. Rather than the end of the world, Revelation speaks with hope about the end of evil in the world, the end of death, and the final fulfillment of the new heaven and the new earth.

Since starting this sermon series on April 11, many of you have expressed support and encouragement – that the sermons have been helpful and inspiring to you, and present an alternative look at this strange book of the Bible. A few others have expressed concern: “Oh no, Revelation again!”

I have been greatly aided in my study of Revelation by the upcoming Presbyterian Women 2010-2011 *Horizon Bible Study*, titled *Journeys through Revelation: Apocalyptic Hope for Today*. This study was written by a Lutheran New Testament scholar, Barbara Rossing, with teaching helps by Presbyterian Educator Louise Lawson Johnson. Last year a group of women here at Beulah served as the field study – testing group for this Bible Study. Their suggestions were incorporated in the final product, and we are grateful for that effort.

I would like to offer a **Summer Revelation Bible Study** here at Beulah, as a supplement to the study that will happen during the year in our various Presbyterian Women Circles (and you women are warmly invited to join a Circle if you are not already in one – contact Helen Sarver at derbygal@windstream.net). This Summer Study would be open to all youth and adults, following the Summer Sunday Morning Worship Service at 9:40, which means the class would start around 10:45.

Due to my own schedule and other summer events here at Beulah, this study will not meet every single Sunday. Here are the tentative dates, with some other details to yet be worked out: June 6, June 20, July 11, July 25, August 1, August 15, August 22, August 29, and September 5 (this last class would meet at 9:30 AM).

Even if you cannot make every class meeting time, you can have the entire study in the *Horizons Bible Study* booklet. The cost is \$7.00, and I would strongly encourage each participant or family involved to purchase this Bible Study. You can order through the church office, by emailing Carol Daugherty at carol@beulahpresbyterian.com.

Remember our Summer Worship Service, for all Sundays in June, July, and August (a slight change from prior years) will begin at 9:40 AM, one hour earlier. So after worship grab some coffee and a cookie, and join us for Bible Study!! Hoping to worship and study with you this summer, I remain,

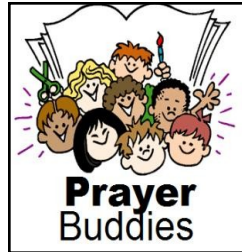

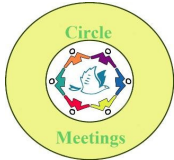

PW Spring Gathering

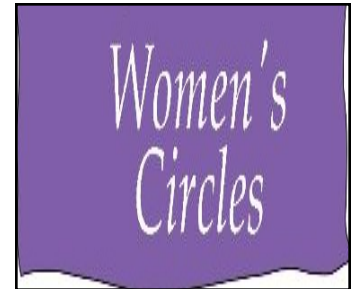
The Mid- Kentucky PW Spring Gathering

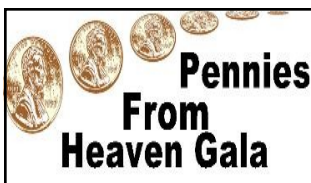
